Certification of Race Official

There are two categories of Race Officers, National Race Officers (NRO) and Senior Race Officer (SRO)

1. Appointments are for up to 3 years beginning on 1 Jan of the following year. Race Officers may apply for renewal at the end of 3 years.

The following conditions must be met to be a certified NRO:-

- (a) Has attended a Race Officer Course and passed the National Race Officer written test.
 - (b) Possess the Powered Pleasure Craft Driving Licence
 - (c) Has served as Assistant Race Officer in at least 2 events in the last year.
2. For renewal of NRO status, the applicant must have served as an NRO for at least 4 events in the last 3 years.
 - 3(i) For certified SRO status, the following conditions must be met:
 - (a) Has been NRO for at least 3 years
 - (b) Has served as *Chief Race Officer* in a Grade 1 event for at least 4 occasions in the last 2 years.
 - 3 (ii) For renewal of SRO status, the applicant must have served as a *Chief Race Officer* in a Grade 1 event for at least 4 events in the last 3 years.

4. Application Procedure

To apply for Race Officer status, applicants are required to complete the registration form and submit to SingaporeSailing by 1 November. Successful applicants will be conferred the relevant Race Officer status for a period of 3 years which will be effective from 1 Jan of the following year. The same procedure will apply for renewals.

5. Graded Events for Race Officer Development

4.1 Grade 1 events

International Championships, National Championships, Class Championships and major regattas which usually take more than one day to complete.
