

Appendix I - Squad Specific Information

National Training Squad Single-handed Junior - Optimist (Jul – Dec 2017 Intake)

Each training squad may consist of up to 16 sailors.

Sailors offered a place in 'A' training squad shall not be considered for 'B' training squad.

Ranking will be taken off the National Optimist Gold Fleet Ranking after the computation of the last ranking event for the period of review, i.e. last ranking event in June 2017.

In order of the following:

1. Top 14 open ranked sailors (min. 4 opposite gender)
2. Top 2 ranked sailors born in 2005 and after.

In order of the following:

1. Top 2 sailors born in 2004 & after (min. 1 opposite gender)
2. Top 6 sailors born in 2005 & after (min. 2 opposite gender)
3. Top 6 sailors born in 2006 & after (min. 2 opposite gender)
4. Top 2 sailors born in 2007 & after (min. 1 opposite gender)

Notes:

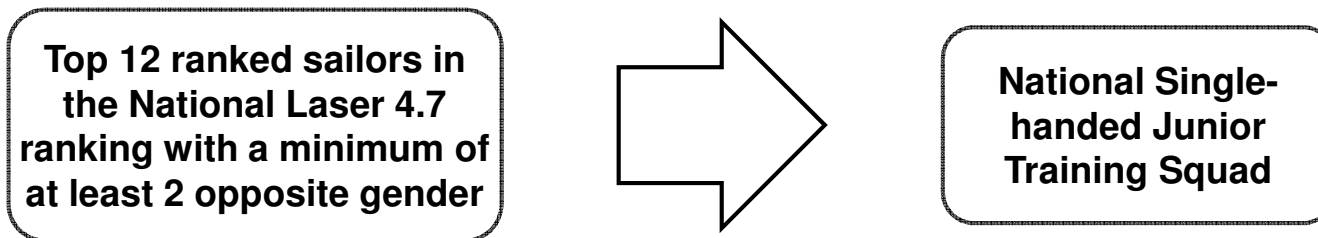
- a) Only sailors in the Optimist Gold Fleet Ranking shall be eligible for invitation.
- b) Should the number of sailors be insufficient for any criteria, the next highest ranked sailor in the Gold Fleet Ranking will be invited.

National Training Squad Single-handed Junior - Laser 4.7 (Jul – Dec 2017 Intake)

The squad may consist of up to 12 sailors.

Prospective sailors shall be aged 17 years and below as of 31st December that year.

Ranking will be taken off the National Laser 4.7 Ranking after the computation of the last ranking event for the period of review, i.e. last ranking event in June 2017.

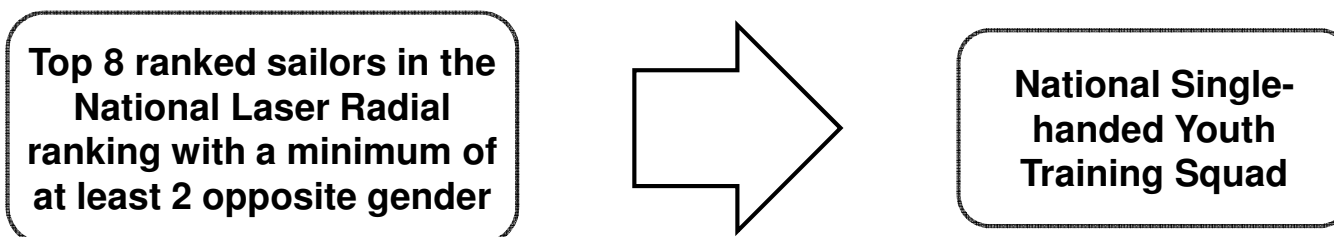


National Training Squad Single-handed Youth - Laser Radial (Jul – Dec 2017 Intake)

The squad may consist of up to 8 sailors.

Prospective sailors shall be aged 19 years and below as of 31st December that year.

Ranking will be taken off the National Laser Radial Ranking after the computation of the last ranking event for the period of review, i.e. last ranking event in June 2017.

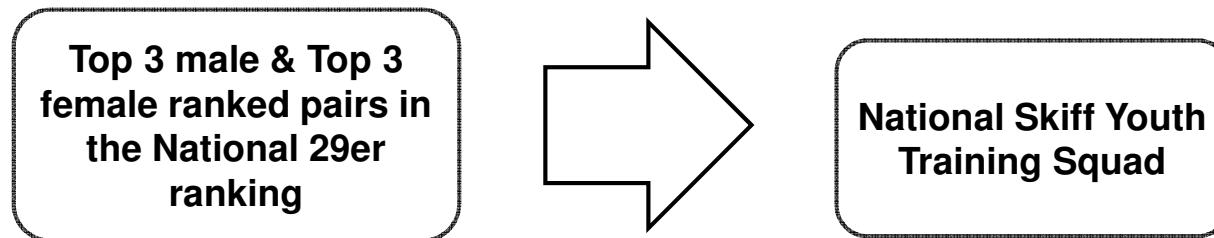


National Training Squad Skiff Youth – 29er (Jul – Dec 2017 Intake)

The squad may consist of up to 3 male pairs and 3 female pairs.

Prospective sailors shall be aged 19 years and below as of 31st December that year.

Ranking will be taken off the National 29er ranking after the computation of the last ranking event for the period of review, i.e. last ranking event in June 2017.



National Training Squad Windsurfing Junior – Techno293 (Jul – Dec 2017 Intake)

The squad may consist of up to 6 windsurfers.

Prospective sailors shall be aged 18 years and below as of 31st December that year.

Nomination Events

1. National Youth C'ship (15 – 18 Mar)
2. Selection Trials (6 – 7 May)
3. Singapore National Sailing C'ship (7 – 11 Jun)

Guidelines for Squad Intake

Notes for Olympic Class Squads:

1. Entry into any Olympic Class Squads will require application to the Head of High Performance. The application period will be in the month of November each year. Forms can be found at this link:

2. Olympic Class Squad sailors must follow training programme set by the coach or high performance manager.

3. Results used for intake guidelines will only be considered if it is:

- i. obtained no earlier than 1 year of the application; and
- ii. relevant to the class which the application is for (i.e. Youth Worlds Gold in the 29er will not be considered for application to Laser Olympic Squad).

4. Once selected, a meeting with the High Performance Manager will be arranged to discuss the plan for the year and targets to meet. Sailors will be required to fill up the Yearly Planning Instrument (YPI) and submit it via email. The file for YPI can be found at this link:
