NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 National prescriptions will apply. For Rule 40 PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICES; LIFE-SAVING EQUIPMENT, add on after the rule, the following: - ‘SingaporeSailing prescribes that every boat shall carry life-saving equipment conforming to Singapore government regulations that apply in the racing area.’
- 1.3 RRS Appendix P, *Special Procedures for Rule 42*, will apply.
- 1.4 All boats must adhere to Maritime Port Authority of Singapore Regulations.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The event is open to all boats of the following class(es):

<i>Double-handed</i>
<i>49er</i>

- 2.2 All competitors are required to have at least an SOF Opti-Racer certification or a Dinghy Proficiency Level 1 for single-handed dinghy sailors. Double-handed sailors will require at least a Dinghy Proficiency Level 2. Windsurfers will require at least a Windsurfing Proficiency Level 1, or Foreign competitors are required to have similar proficiency certifications.
- 2.3 Competitors must be a member of an affiliated to Singapore Sailing Federation, or for the case of foreign competitors, must be a member of an affiliate to their respective member national authority for sailing.

3 FEES

4 COMPETITION FORMAT

The regatta will consist of a single series.

5.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1100h.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at National Sailing Centre at least 1 week before the start of the respective class selections.

7 VENUE

7.1 Attachment 1 shows the location of the regatta centre.

7.2 Attachment 2 shows the location of the racing areas.

8 THE COURSES

The diagrams in Attachment 3 show the courses, including the order in which marks are to be passed and the side on which each mark is to be left.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1 If International Jury is appointed, decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

9.2 For the 49er class, rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty

10 SCORING

Three races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

11 SUPPORT BOATS

Support Boat Regulation shall apply.

12 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park.



13 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

16 MEDIA RIGHTS, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

16.1 By participating in an event, competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority, their sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.

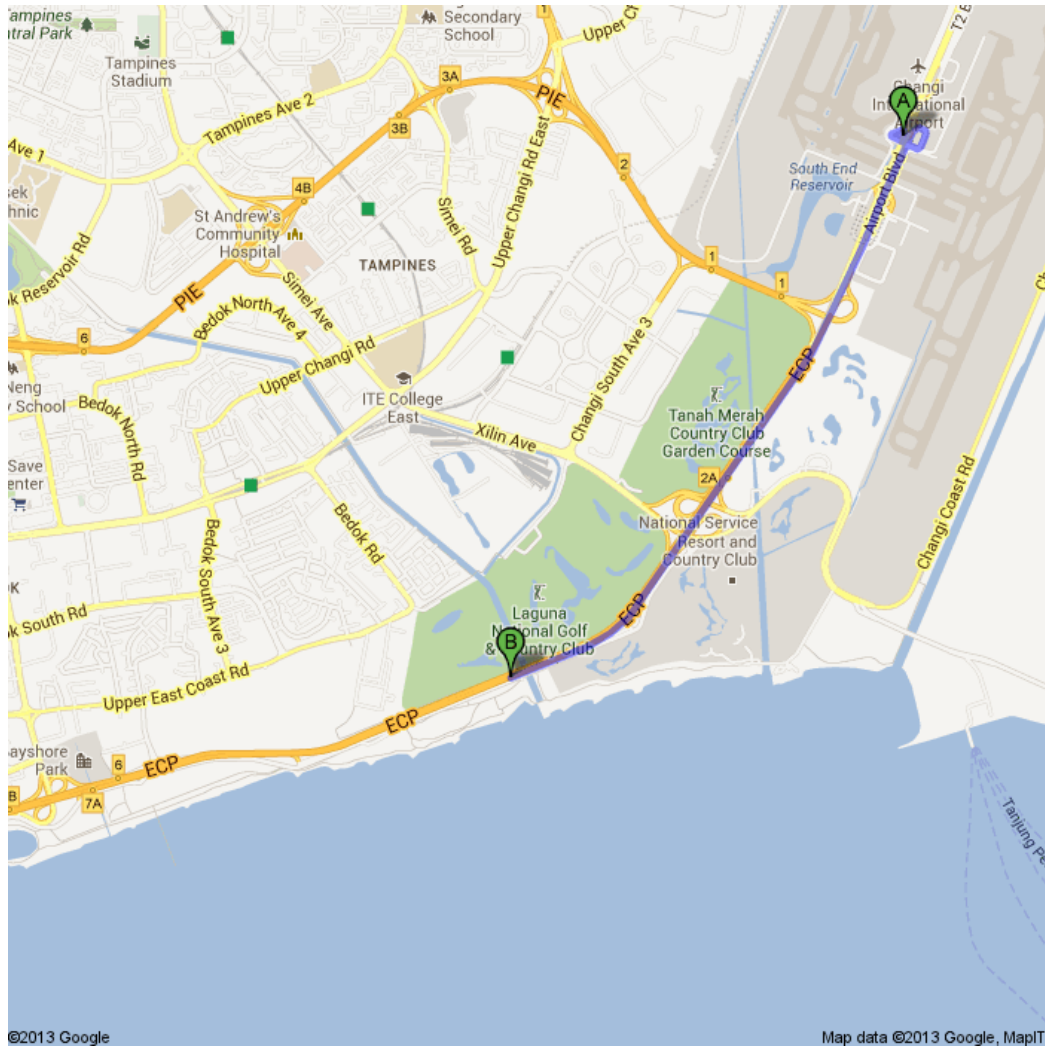
16.2 Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment and positioning equipment as specified by the Organising Authority.

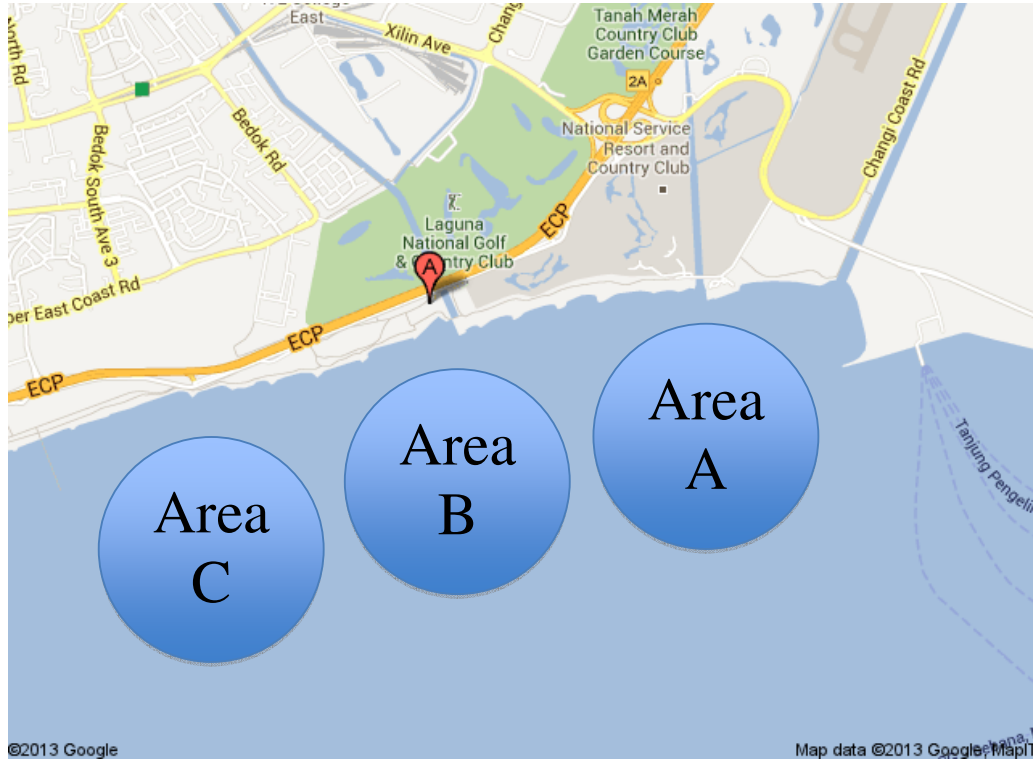
Attachment 1



Directions from Changi Airport to National Sailing Centre:


- 1) Head North on Airport Blvd






