

Appendix I - Squad Specific Information

National Single-handed Youth Dinghy Training Squad - Laser Radial (Jul – Dec 2020 Intake)

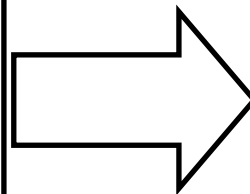
The squad may consist of up to 16 sailors.

Sailors shall be 18 years and under in the year of intake (i.e. born after 31 December 2001).

Ranking will be taken off the National Laser Radial Ranking after the computation of the last ranking event for the period of review, i.e. last ranking event in June 2020.

In order of the following until squad size reaches 16 sailors:

1. Top 6 male and top 6 female ranked sailors in the National Laser Radial ranking
2. Up to 4 sailors who are current members of the National Single-handed Junior Squad - Laser 4.7, and due to age or physical characteristics, that choose to change class may be invited as full National Training Squad members or be invited as Sparring Partners.
3. Next top ranked sailor in the National Laser Radial ranking

Notes:

1. To be eligible for criteria 1 and 3, sailors are required to be top 20 ranked in the above selection process. Should there be an insufficient number of males or females in the National Laser Radial Ranking to fulfil the gender criteria, any unfulfilled quota will be offered to the next highest ranked sailor regardless of gender.
2. Current members of the National Single-handed Junior Training Squad - Laser 4.7 who wish to be invited into the training squad shall indicate by email to the High Performance Manager, by the month of May (for July intake) or by the month of November (for January intake), of their intention to be considered under the 2nd criteria.
 - a. These sailors should also indicate when they are able to join the National Single-handed Youth Training Squad if invited.
 - b. Should there be more than 4 sailors who indicate their intention to be considered, priority will be given to the higher ranked sailor of the National Laser 4.7 ranking at the end of the present intake.
