

Appendix I - Squad Specific Information

National Single-handed Junior Dinghy Training Squad - Laser 4.7 (Jul – Dec 2020 Intake)

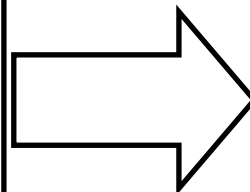
The squad may consist of up to 16 sailors.

Sailors shall be between age 12 and 17 on 31 December 2020 (born after 31 December 2003 and no later than 31 December 2008).

Ranking will be taken off the National Laser 4.7 Ranking after the computation of the last ranking event for the period of review, i.e. last ranking event in Jun 2020.

In order of the following:

1. Top 5 male and top 5 female ranked sailors in the National Laser 4.7 ranking
2. Top ranked male and female sailor in the National Laser 4.7 ranking born in 2007 or after
3. Up to 4 sailors (sailors graduating from Optimist NTS A & B, 2 male and 2 female sailors) may be invited as training partners. Invitation will be based on ranking in Optimist Gold Fleet ranking.

Notes:

1. Should there be an insufficient number of males or females in the National Laser 4.7 Ranking to fulfil the gender criteria, any unfulfilled quota will be offered to the next highest ranked sailor regardless of gender.
2. Current members of the National Single-handed Junior Training Squad - Optimist who wish to be invited into the training squad shall indicate by email to the High Performance Manager, by the month of May (for July intake) or by the month of November (for January intake), of their intention to be considered under the 3rd criteria.
 - a. These sailors should also indicate when they are able to join the National Single-handed Junior Training Squad - Laser 4.7 if invited.
 - b. Should there be more than 4 sailors who indicate their intention to be considered, priority will be given to the higher ranked sailor of the National Optimist Gold Fleet ranking at the end of the present intake.
